

MEDICATION DISPOSAL INFORMATION

What is allowed?

- Liquid medications (sealed in the original container)
- Over-the-counter medicines
- Medicated ointments and lotions
- Pet medications
- Prescription medications
- Prescription patches
- Vitamins



- Bloody or infectious waste
- Chemotherapy drugs
- Needles or sharps of any kind
- Thermometers
- Schedule I controlled substances
 - marijuana, heroin, or LSD



Always remember to:

- Put all pills in one zip-top bag, seal it tightly and drop the bag into the collection receptacle
- Trash or recycle the empty pill containers after you remove or scratch out personal information
- If other packaging, such as cardboard boxes, can be easily removed, please dispose of it separately.
